H.B. 487 Career-Technical Education Resolution

WHEREAS, section 3313.90 of the Ohio Revised Code stipulates that local school districts may adopt a resolution that specifies the district's intent not to provide career-technical education to students enrolled in grades seven and eight for a particular school year;

AND

WHEREAS, section 3313.90 further provides that if the district submits that resolution to the Ohio Department of Education by the thirtieth day of September of that school year, the department shall waive the requirement for that district to provide a career-technical education to students enrolled in grades seven and eight for that particular school year.

THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Louisville City Schools' Board Of Education hereby waives the requirement to provide career-technical in grades seven and eight for the 2015-16 school year as allowed by Section 3313.90.
