On Tuesday, February 28 all juniors will take the ACT test at Louisville High School. Success on the ACT can provide access to scholarship opportunities, as well as give great information on areas of strength and growth for college and career. It is an alternative to demonstrating competency in English and Math. Remediation free in all areas earns the College Ready Seal for graduation, and a score of 27 can help a student towards an Honors Diploma!
