Month: August/September

Big Ideas:

Labels: represent ways to address, name, and identify objects, people, and/or places/events. Labels allow children to catalog, classify, search, and assign values/tags

Function-Rules: expectations or regulations of behavior or language (written or spoken) at home, at school, and in the community

Function-Object: tools, devices, materials, mediums, toys, body parts, modes of transportation, and structures.

Comprehending: when a child remembers, recalls from memory, understands information AND uses/acts upon the information. Children use or act upon information recalled, verbally (e.g., asking and answering questions, telling) and non-verbally (e.g., following directions, matching, imitating).

I can cut. I can talk about size, shape and color. I can sequence.	I can write I can use words to talk about things.	I can count. I can read. I can follow directions.
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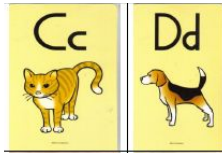
Organizer: Welcome to School, All About Me and My Family

Pretend Play	Babies, baby care items, housekeeping, kitchen and cooking materials
Block Center	Wooden Blocks, books about building, vehicles, block people
Library Center	Fiction and non-fiction books about school and families, puzzles, class books
Table Toys	Small blocks, books and other fine motor manipulatives
Creation Station	Crayons, colored pencils, oil pastels, bingo dotters, pencils, tape, glue sticks, paper, clipboards, colored paper
Sensory Table	Kinetic Sand and sand toys
Sensory Table	Plastic beads, plastic balls, spoons, and measuring cups
Writing Center	Wooden letter building pieces, mat-man pieces, chalkboards, white boards
Science Center	Sensory bottles, scale and items for weighing, globe, flags, magnifying glasses, books
Lego Wall	Regular Legos and Lego wall
Light Table	Colored building legos
