Policies and Procedures

As a result of the COVID 19 pandemic, the District has established policies and procedures to allow students and staff return to school and work safely.

Universal and correct wearing of masks

Procedures are in place and used based on recommendations of the health department

Physical distancing

Procedures are in place and used based on recommendations of the health department

Handwashing and respiratory etiquette (as needed/required)

Procedures are in place and used based on recommendations of the health department

Cleaning and maintaining healthy facilities, including improving ventilation

Procedures are in place and used based on recommendations of the health department
in conjunction with the District's maintenance department

Contact tracing in combination with isolation and quarantine, in collaboration with health departments

Procedures are in place and used based on recommendations of the health department
in conjunction with the District's nursing staff

Diagnostic and screening testing

Procedures are in place and used based on recommendations of the health department
in conjunction with the District's nursing staff

Efforts to provide vaccinations to educator, other staff and students, if eligible

Procedures are in place and used based on recommendations of the health department
(All employees were offered vaccinations through the health department)

Appropriate accommodations for children with disabilities with respect to the health and safety policies

Procedures are in place and used based on recommendations of the health department
in conjunction with the District's special programs office

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Continuity of Services

The Louisville City School District provided in-person and virtual learning district-wide with the implementation of many safety protocols during the 2020-21 school year and plans to continue this for the 2021-22 school year based on the current status of the COVID 19 pandemic.

In addition to the regular school day/year, the District is utilizing ESSER funds to address student learning loss through after school tutoring and extended year programs (i.e. acceleration camp). ESSER funds are also planned to be used to continue to purchase cleaning supplies and other equipment to provide safe and healthy environments for all students and staff in all district buildings.

Periodic Review

The District's plan will continually be assessed and adjusted as needed throughout allowable use timeline for the grant (i.e. June 30, 2024) with periodic reviews completed no less frequently than every six months.
