Students must have a form turned in every 9 weeks in order to be eligible to earn their Academic Letter.

ACT Testing

Louisville High School will be administering the ACT free of charge for all juniors this year on Tuesday, February 23rd. All juniors are required to take this state assessment. There is no sign up necessary for the administration of the ACT.

The test will be given during the school day from 8 a.m. until approximately 11:30 a.m. (at LHS) and will NOT include the writing portion. All juniors will be dismissed to go home after testing.

The cafeteria will be open should any junior wish to eat lunch here. Any junior who will be staying at school all day should report to D117 until dismissal. An email will be sent in February explaining ACT testing in more detail.



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College Credit Plus Mandatory Viewing

This is a reminder to all parents and students who plan on taking College Credit Plus classes at Louisville High School or on a College Campus next school year. There is a power point located on our website (louisvillecityschools.org) that is MANDATORY to view. This power point will walk you through all the steps necessary for students to earn college credit while in high school and answering all of the questions that you may have regarding this program.

No student will be permitted to take a college credit plus class without having viewed this power point with their parent(s). You will also be required to fill out the intent form online, stating that you and your student have viewed the power point and understand the steps necessary to take CC+ classes.

Keep in mind that filling out the intent form alone does NOT mean you are eligible to take CC+ classes. There are other steps that you must go through to be eligible take college classes. This includes filling out a college application of the school of choice and being accepted into the college.

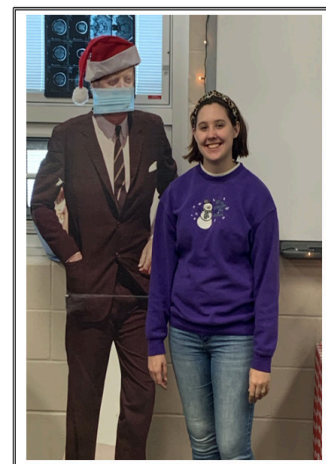
